TERMS OF REFERENCE RESEARCH ETHICS TRAINING CONSULTANT

Country: Madagascar
Location: Flexible (global/virtual)
Intervention Zone: Vatovavy Fitovinany and Atsimo Atsinanana Regions

Context

In October 2019, ADRA Madagascar started implementing a food security project called FIOVANA – which means change in Malagasy – in southeastern Madagascar. FIOVANA is a five-year project with a goal of "Sustainable improvement of food and nutritional security and the resilience of the vulnerable population in the regions of Atsimo Atsinanana and Vatovavy Fitovinany, in the south-east of Madagascar." Being a multisectoral project, it consists of three objectives to achieve food security, which are:

1. Sustainable improvement in the health and nutritional status of pregnant and breastfeeding women, adolescent girls and children under 5;
2. Improvement of household income to access basic food and non-food products and build up savings;
3. Improved management of social and ecological risks.

Currently, the project is conducting a number of research activities in order to better understand the context of the target regions and adjust the technical approaches before the actual start of the implementation of field activities.

Description of the Post

FIOVANA staff who are involved in the project's research activities – particularly those involved in research that has received IRB approval – must be trained and certified in research ethics.

An expert consultant is sought to conduct a one day, 4-hour remote research ethics training for FIOVANA and partner staff based in Madagascar and the United States in November or December 2020, with the purpose of helping staff meet the IRB research ethics certification requirements. The exact date of the training is to be determined based on the consultant and FIOVANA staff availability. The training will be conducted in French, or in English with simultaneous translation into French provided by the project.

Required Qualifications

- Master's or PhD in the social or biological sciences
- Expertise in research ethics
- Experience delivering research ethics trainings and issuing certifications to meet IRB standards
- Fluency in French (preferred but not required)
